- Organise and oversee logistics activities and functioning
- Organise inbound and outbound of domestic and international shipment via direct or 3PL deliveries
- Monitor shipping routing, scheduling planning, and capacity utilization of resources
- Monitor inventory levels and oversee the movement of incoming and outgoing goods
- Monitoring shipments, deliveries, timelines and costs
- Prepare import/export shipping documentation, such as Bill of lading, Proforma invoice, SLI, packing list, and/or manufacturer's declaration
